



## PHRASAL VERBS (T)

### take after

- *Resemble in appearance*  
She takes after her Mom and her brother resembles their Dad.

### take apart

- *dismantle or separate*  
The repairman had to dismantle and open my laptop to find the problem.

### take away

- *buy food and take it elsewhere*  
Can I have two boxes as take away please?

### take back

- *agree to return*  
They only take back unopened goods with a receipt.

### take care of

- *look after*  
Many grandparents take care of their grandchildren after school.

### take off

- *leave the ground*  
The flight will take off at 7:00pm.

### take in

- *allow to stay with*  
The SPCA always takes in stray animals that they find.
- *Notice with your eyes*  
She took in every detail of that performance and repeats it flawlessly.
- *Understand what is happening*  
After taking in the scene outside the mall, he called the police.

### take on

- *hire*  
They will take on many new employees once they complete the expansion.

### take out

- *remove*  
The student took out a pencil and notebook.
- *Invite to a social event*  
I want to take her out to dinner and a movie afterwards.

### tell off

- *Reprimand or scold*  
Her parents really told her off for not attending classes regularly.

### test out

- *Carry out experiment*  
I work out for at least two hours every other day at the gym.  
*find a solution*  
We need to work out and find all the problems in that proposal.

### think over

- *considerer*  
I will have to think it over very carefully before I make my final decision.

### throw away

- *discard or get rid of*  
Please throw away all the food that has already gone by the use-by-date – it can be dangerous.

### throw up

- *vomit or be sick*  
There was something bad in the food and everyone started throwing up after returning from lunch.

### tire out

- *exhaustion*  
The active grandchildren will tire out their grandparents very quickly.

### touch down

- *arrive on the runway*  
The flight will touch down one hour late because of delays at the departure.

### trade-in

- *part payment for replacement*  
They will accept your current car as a trade-in equal to the deposit when you buy a new model.
